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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PINE ISLAND POA, INC.

A NON-PROPIT CORPORATION

I, the undersigned natural person of the age of eighteen years or more, do hereby make and acknowledge these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of North Carolina, as contained in Chapter 5th of the Gineral Statutes of North Carolina, entitled to that end do hereby ser forth:

- 1. The name of the corporation is PINY ISLAND-POA, INC. (hereinafter called the "Association"):

- 3. The purpose of purposes for which the Association is
 - (a) This accountion does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the sembors thereof, and the specific purposes for which it is formed are to provide for the administration, maintenance and nunsgement of the community and iscilling known as "Pine Island" (the "Community") according to that Certain "Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions", as some may be amended from time to time covering and regarding that certain tract(s) or parcel(s) of land described on:
 - All that certain parcel or parcels of land shown on a plat or plate entitled "Pine Island" which may or will be recorded from time to time in the Office Of the Register of Deeds of Currituck County, North Carolina, reference to which is hereby made,

and to promote the health, eafety and welface of the residents within the Community;

- (b) To exercise all the powers and privileges and to perform a) I the dutics and obligations of the Association as set forth in said Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions, hereinafter called the "Declaration", applicable to the proporties monitioned above and seconded or to be recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Currituck County, North time to time as the same may be amended or supplemented from time to time as therein provided, the Declaration being incomporated herein as if set forth in its entireties;
- (c) To fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by any lawful means, all charges, ansessments, or common expenses pursuant to the terms of the Declaration; to pay all expenses in connection therewith and all office and other expenses including all licenses; texas or governmental charges levied or imposed against the property(ies) maintained and managed by the Association;
- (d) To have and to exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a corporation organized under the non-protit corporation laws of the State of North Carolina may now or hereafter have or exercise.
- 4. The Association shall have members which shall consist solely of the owners of lots in the property or properties known as time laland, and membership in the Association may be transferred

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only as an incident to the transfer of the Owner's interest is a lot constituting a portion of the properties described in the Declaration, and any such transfer shall be subject to the procedures and matters set forth in the Declaration and other documents referred to therein.

- 5. The directors of the Association shall be elected by the members and in the manner provided in the bylaws.
- 6. No part of the ner income or not earnings of the Association shall inure to the benefit of any officer, director or member of the Association; upon dissolution of this hequisition the assets thereof shall, after all of its liabilities and obligations have been discharged or adequate provision made there for, be distributed to any corporation(s), organization(s) or association(s) organized for the purposes or engaged in activities substantially similar to those set forth in Article Three (3) hereinabove, all as more particularly may be provided in the bylaws of the Association.
- 7. Every director and every officer of the Association shall he indemnified by the Association against all supenses and liabilities, including counsel fees, reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with any proceeding to which he may be a purely, or in which he may become involved, by reason of his being or having been a director or officer of the Association, whether or not he is a director or officer at the time such expenses are incurred, except in such cases wherein the director or officer is adjudged guilty of willful misfessauce or malfessance in the performence of his duties; provided that, in the event of any claim for reimbursement or indemnification hereunder based upon a settlement by the director or officer seeking such raimbursement or indemnification, the indemnification herein shall only apply if the Board of Directors approves such settlement and reimbursement as being in the best interest of the Association. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which such director or officer may be entitled.
